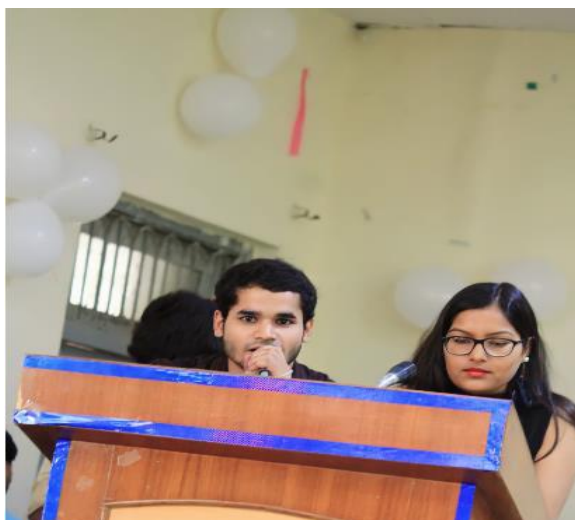

8. Webinar on 'Innovative Trends in Phytopharmacology'

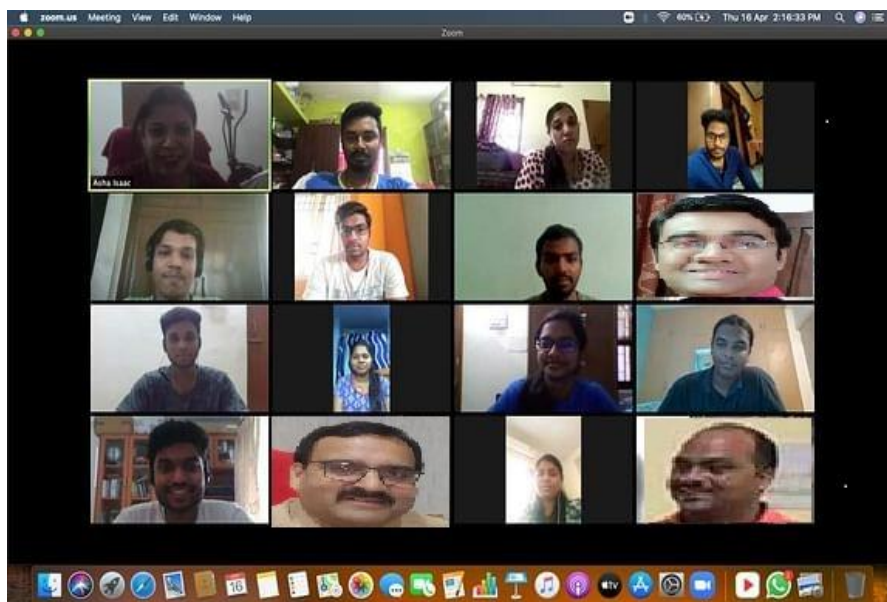
Date: June 30, 2020

23. Career Counselling Sessions: “How to Score Better in Aptitude Tests”

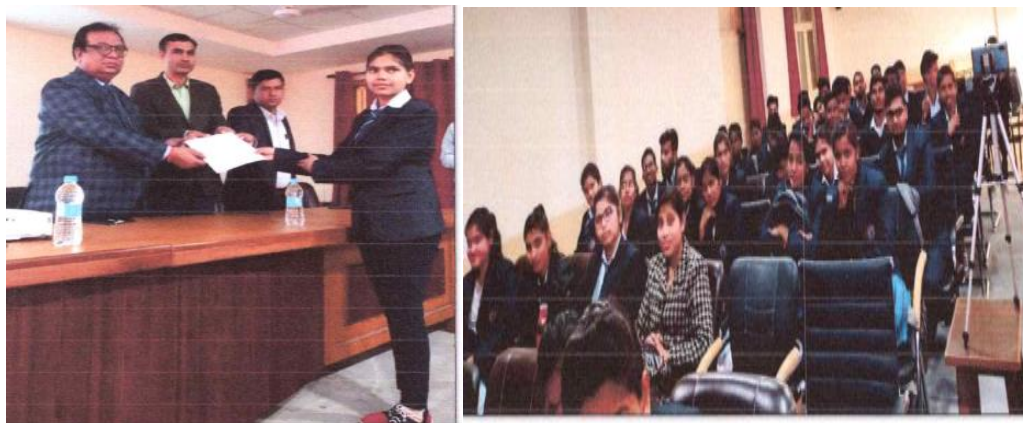
Date: February 04, 05 & 07, 2020

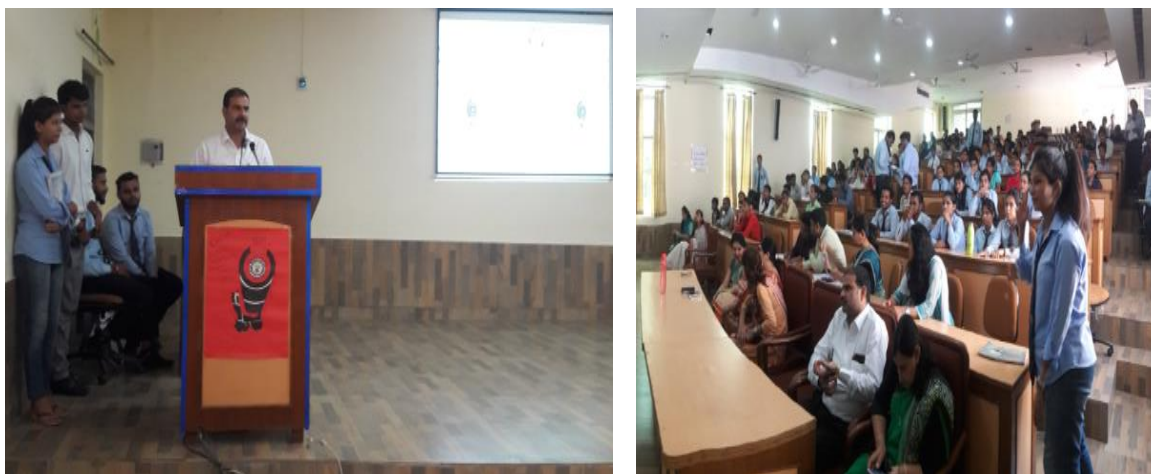
