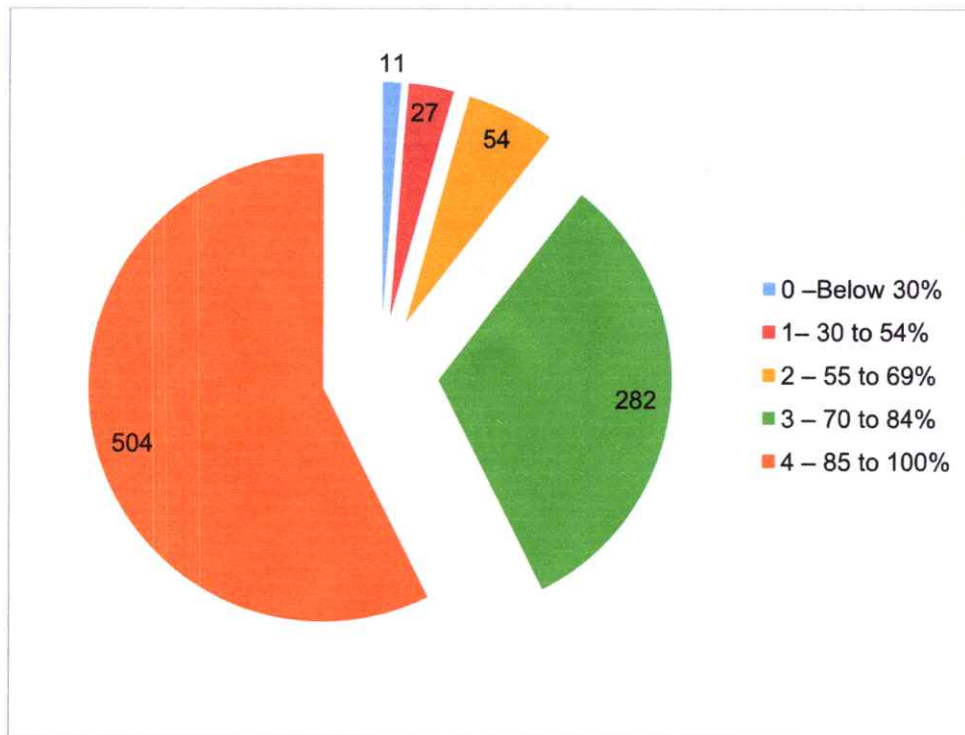
The students' responses were sought in reference to their experience; and covered following dimensions –

The weighted average score for this parameter was found 3.41. The survey revealed students' satisfaction and syllabus was found well covered during the session.

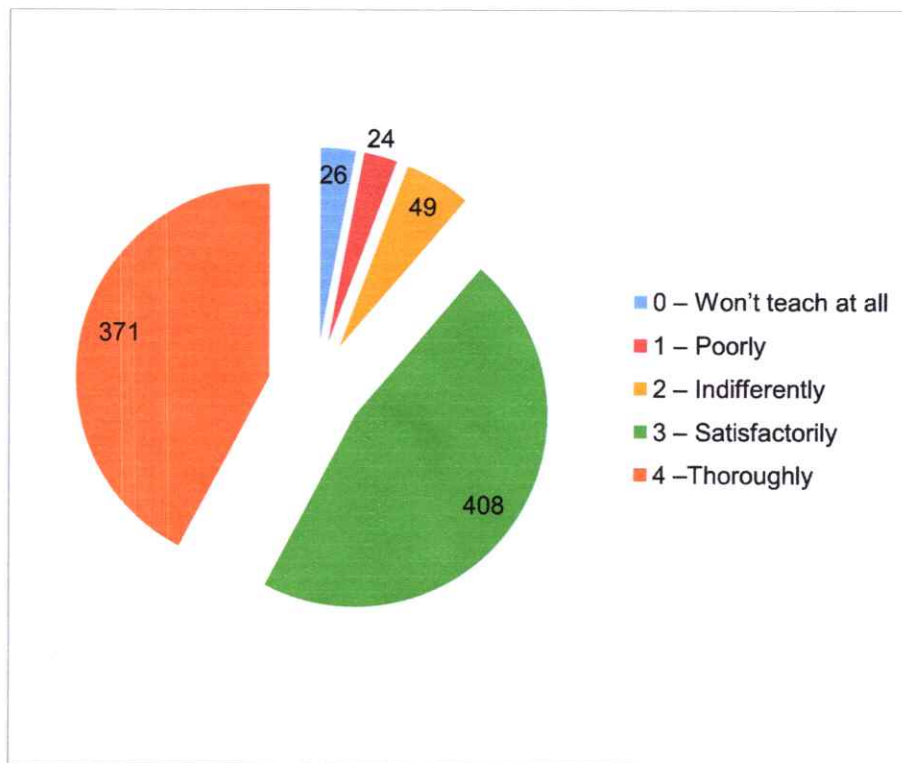


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2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

The weighted average found was 3.22 reflecting the desired performance levels.

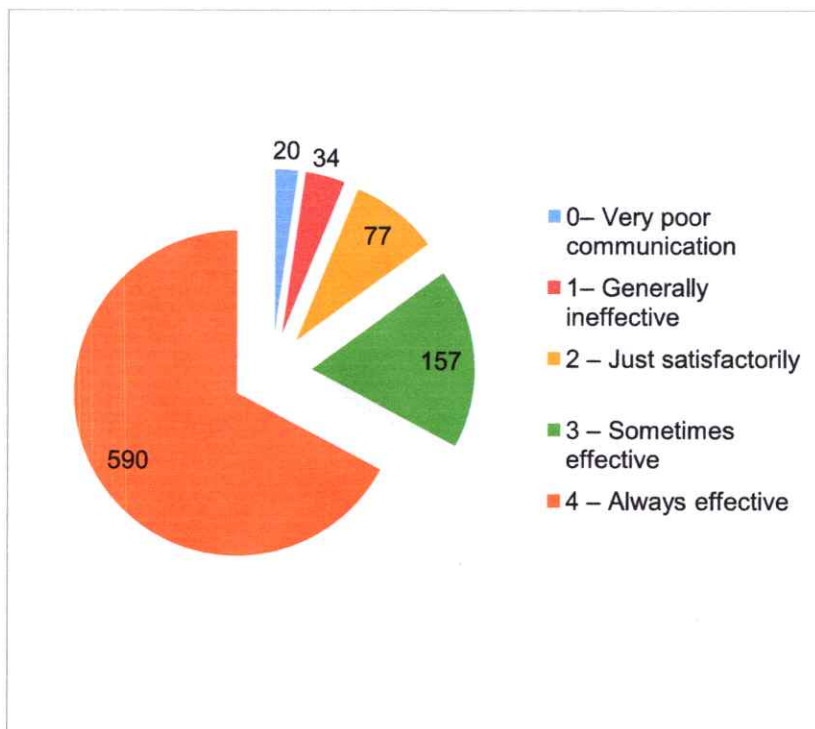


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3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

The weighted average was found 3.44 reflecting the teachers' sound ability to communicate with their students.

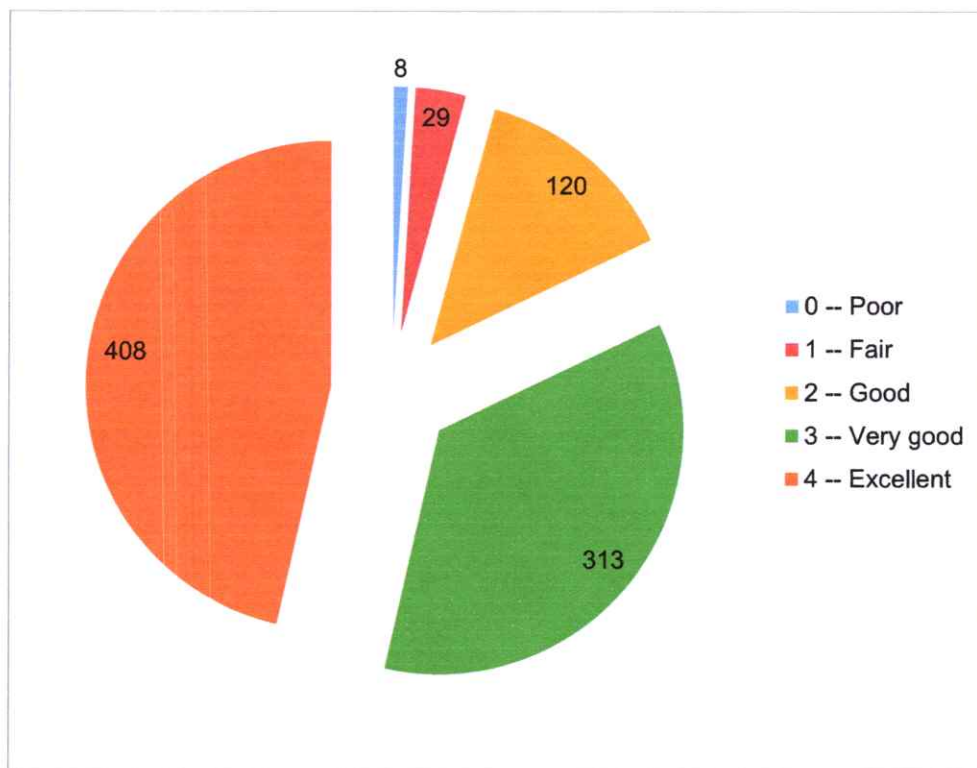


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4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

The weighted average was found 3.23 indicating an ideal approach of teachers towards teaching.

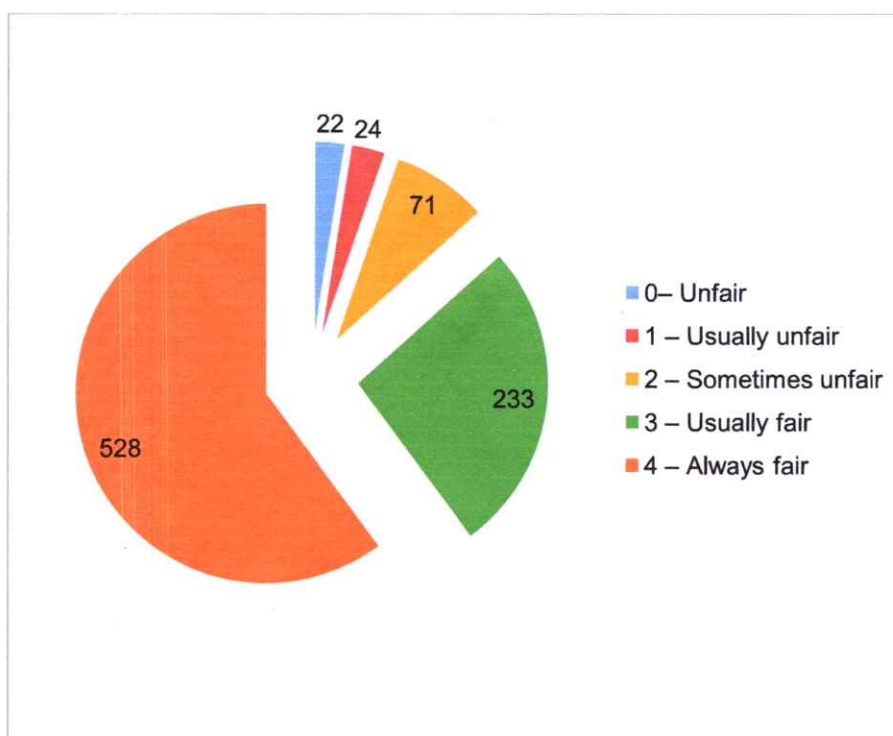


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5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers:

The weighted average was found 3.39 and students found the internal evaluation process as fair.

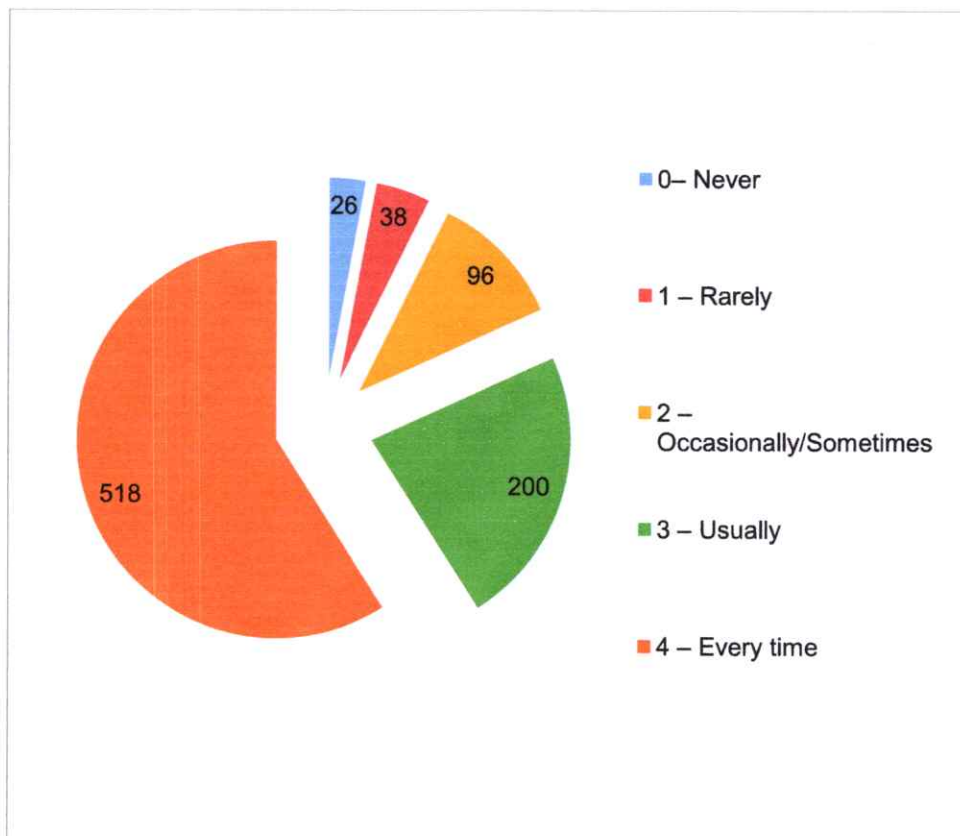

The weighted average was found 3.31 and students shared their satisfaction with the guidance and feedback being provided to them on their assignments.



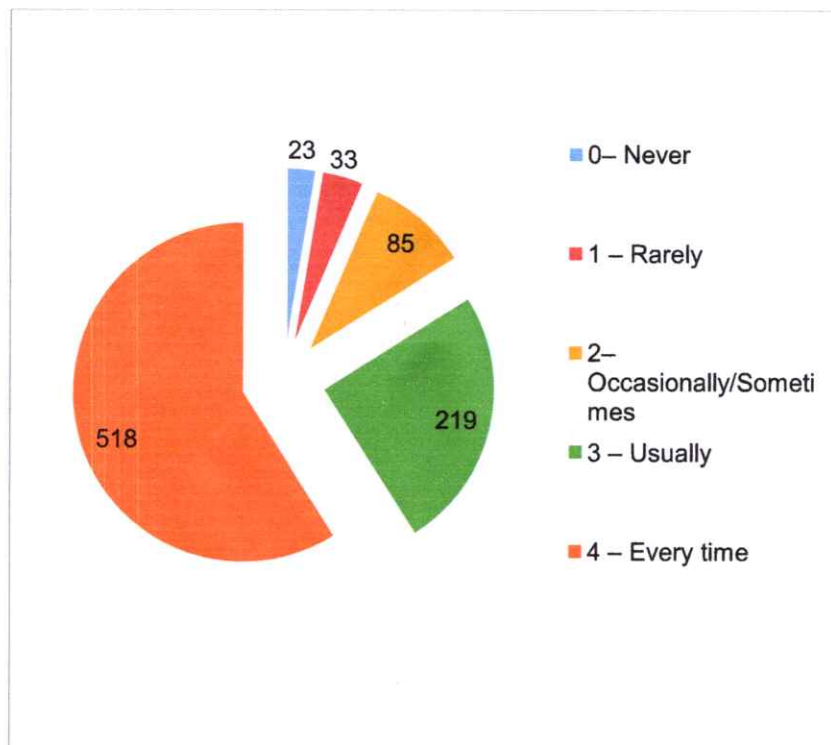
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7. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

The weighted average was found 3.34.

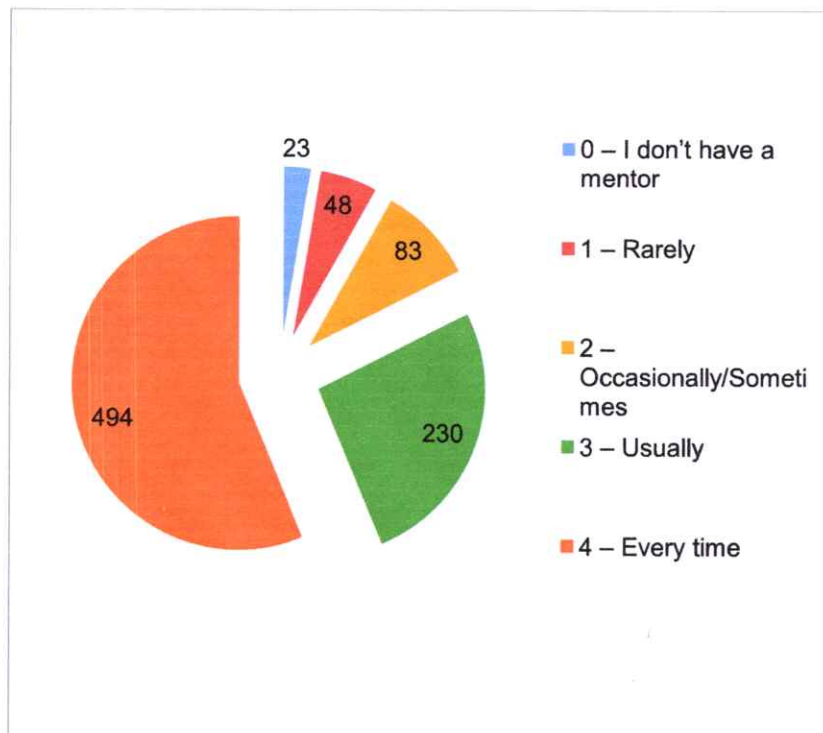


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8. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.

The weighted average was found 3.28 and the survey revealed that teachers do follow up (remind) students about the assignment given.

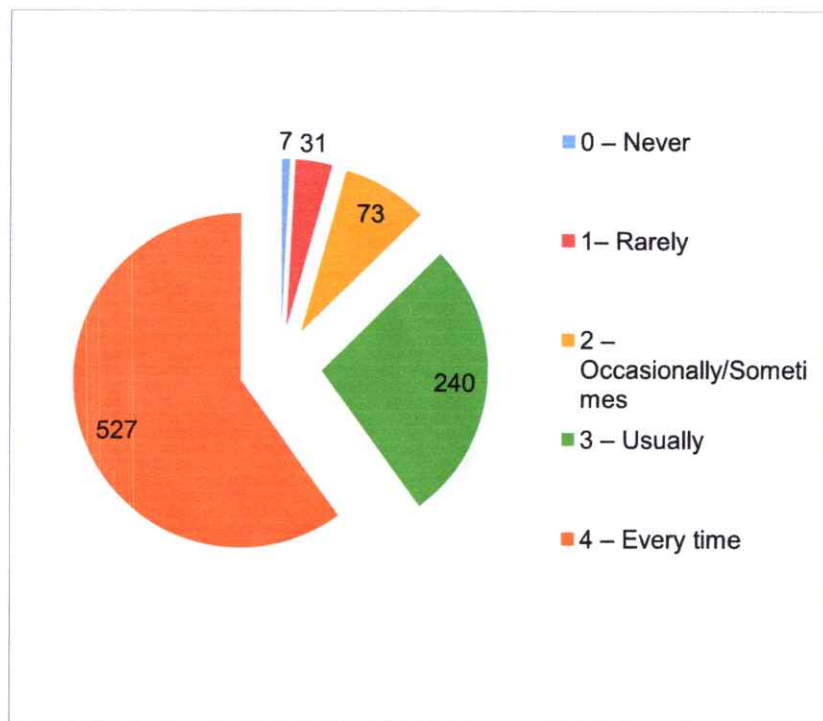


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9. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

The weighted average on this parameter was found 3.42 and students concurred that teachers use appropriate examples during the classroom discussion.

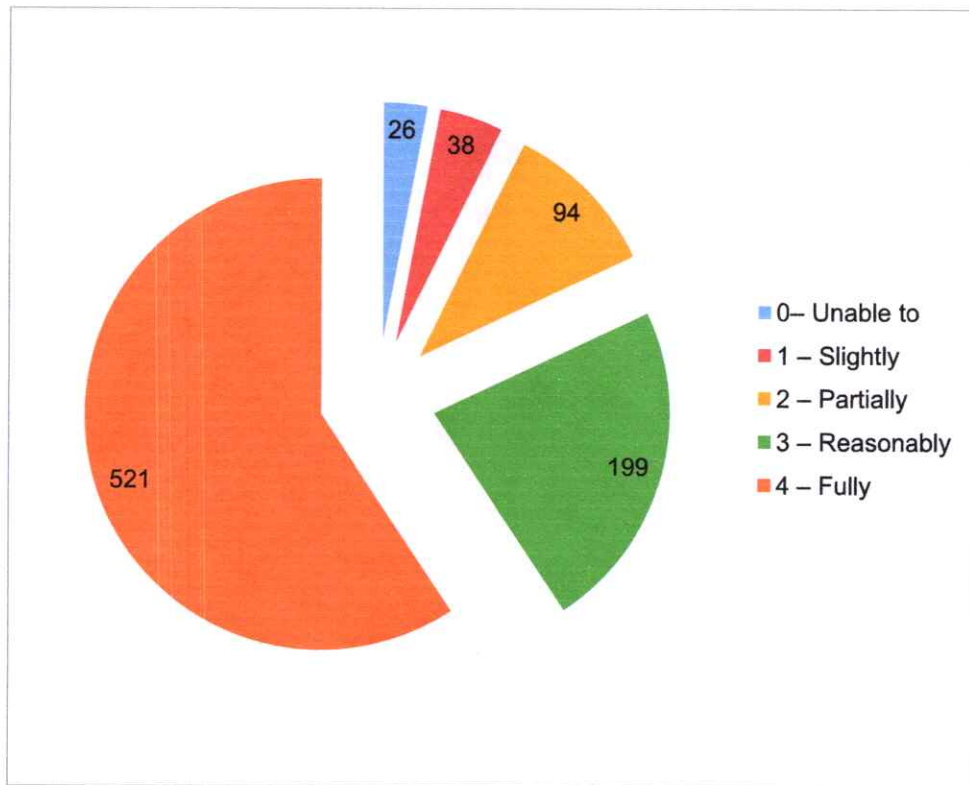


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10. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.

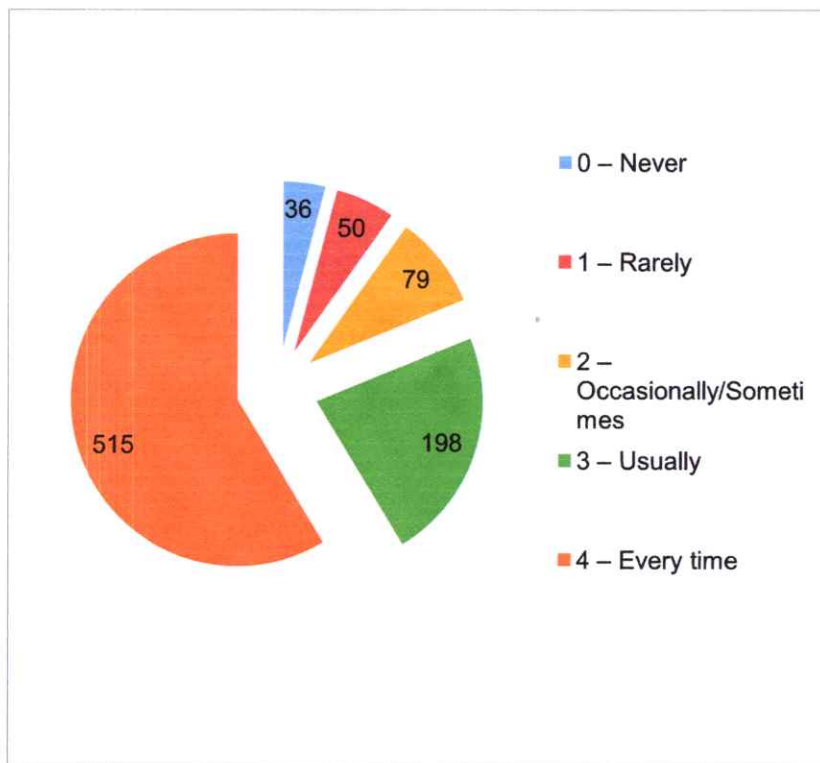
The weighted average was found 3.31 and students found their tasks / assignments of appropriate difficulty level.

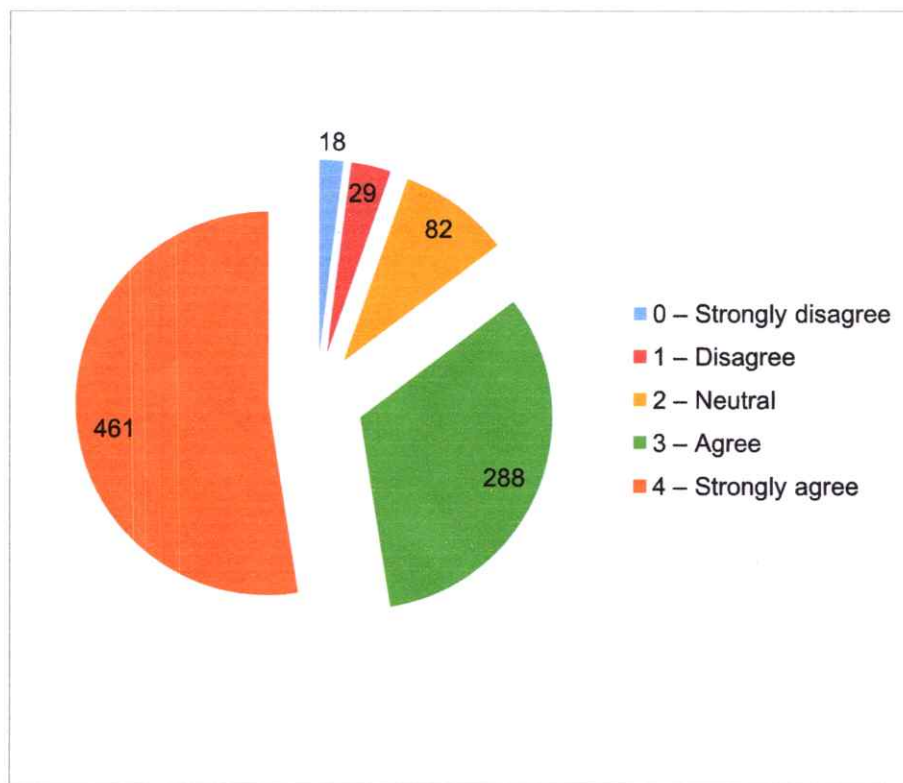
The weighted average was found 3.26 and students shared that the teachers provide counseling and help them identify their weaknesses.

The weightage average was found 3.30 and teachers were found encouraging their students to participate in extracurricular activities.

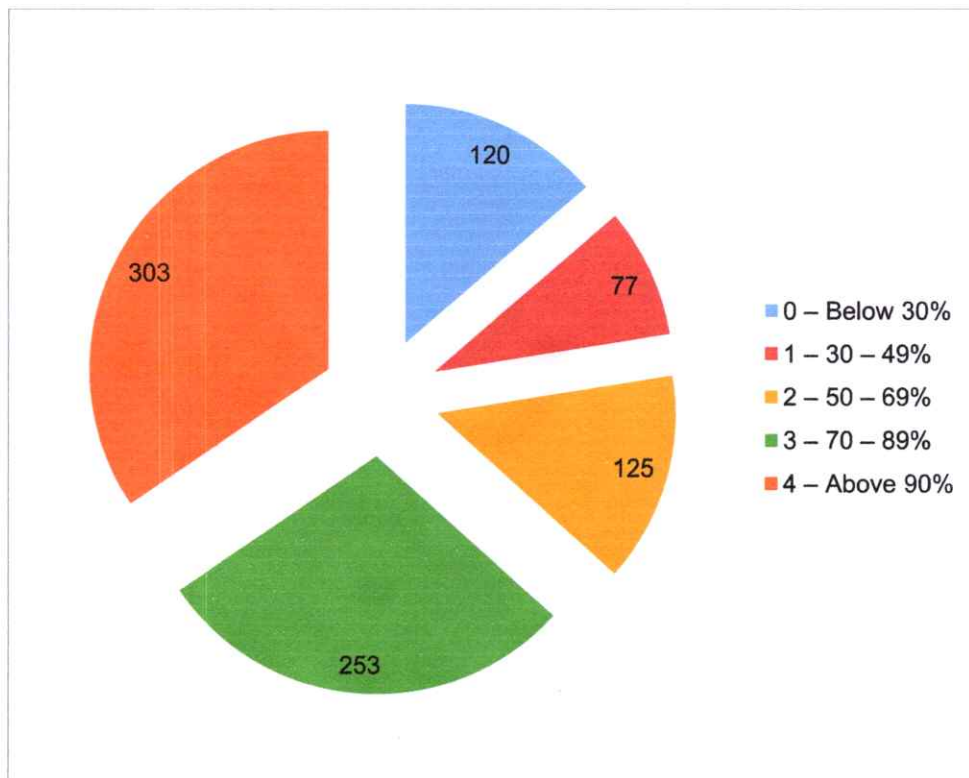


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13. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching?

The weightage mean response for this parameter was found 2.62. The survey outcome revealed that provisioning of ICT tools is an agenda that requires attention of the concerned stake holders.

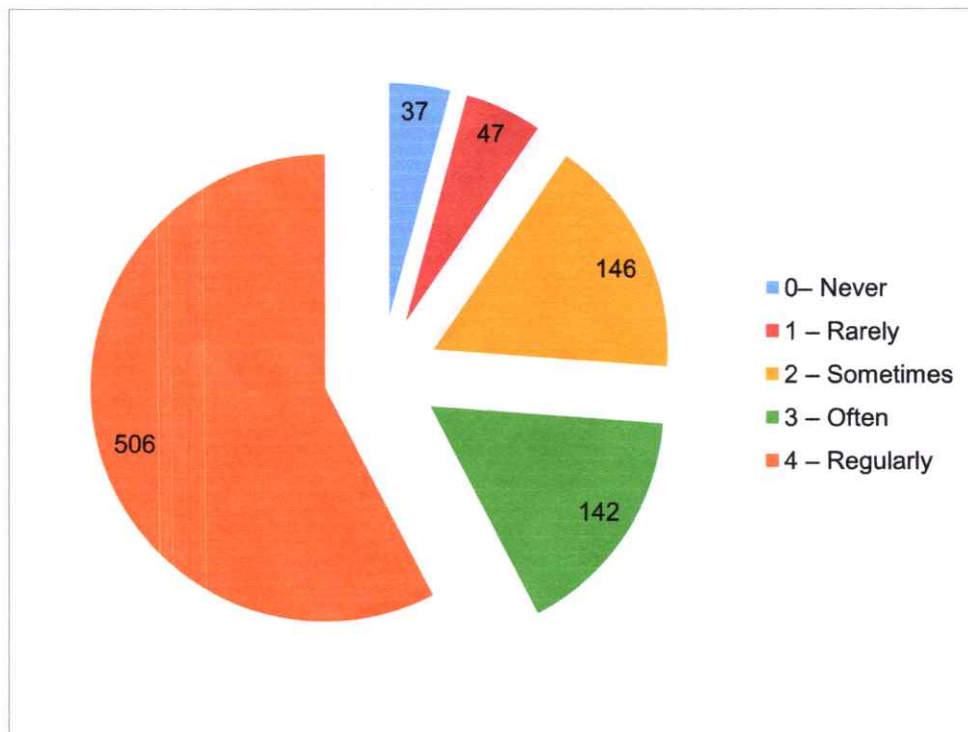


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14. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.

The weighted average was found 3.18. The score indicated that the internship and field visit opportunities needs to be scaled up.

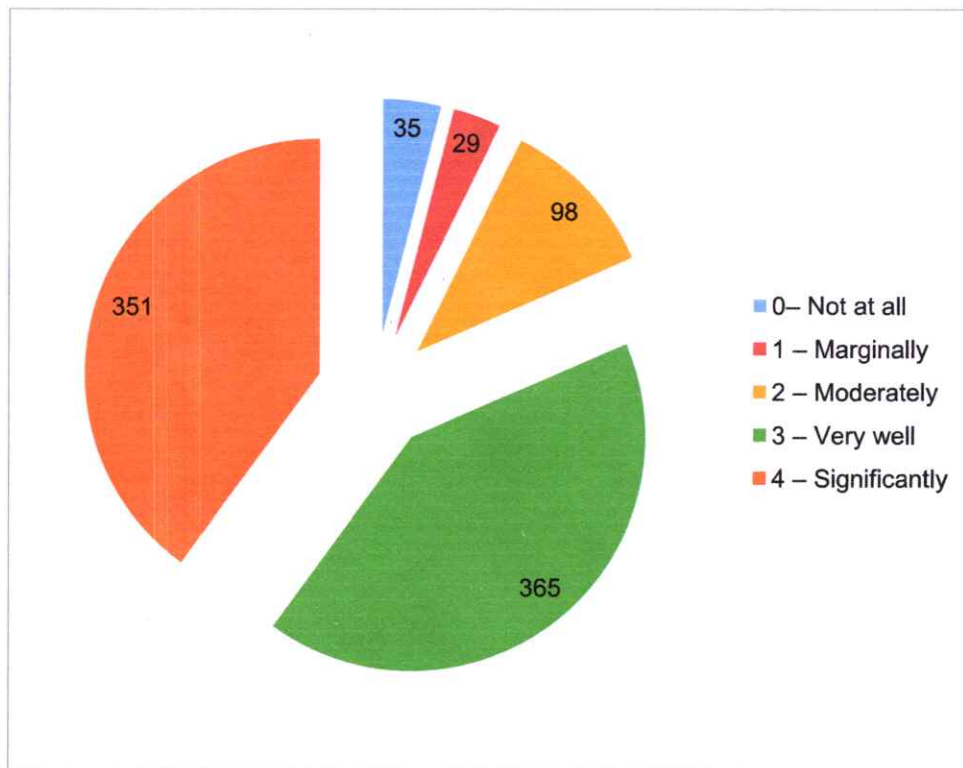


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15. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

The weighted average was found 3.10. A considerable number of students found that the institution facilitates them in their cognitive, social and emotional growth.

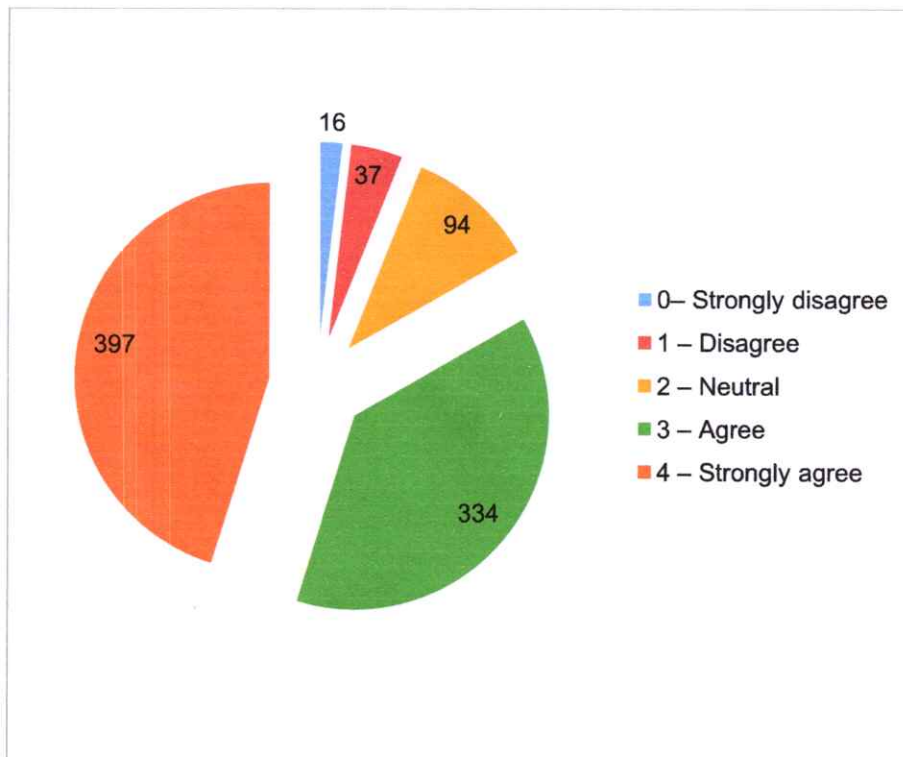


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16. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

The weighted average was found 3.21 and students agreed that their institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

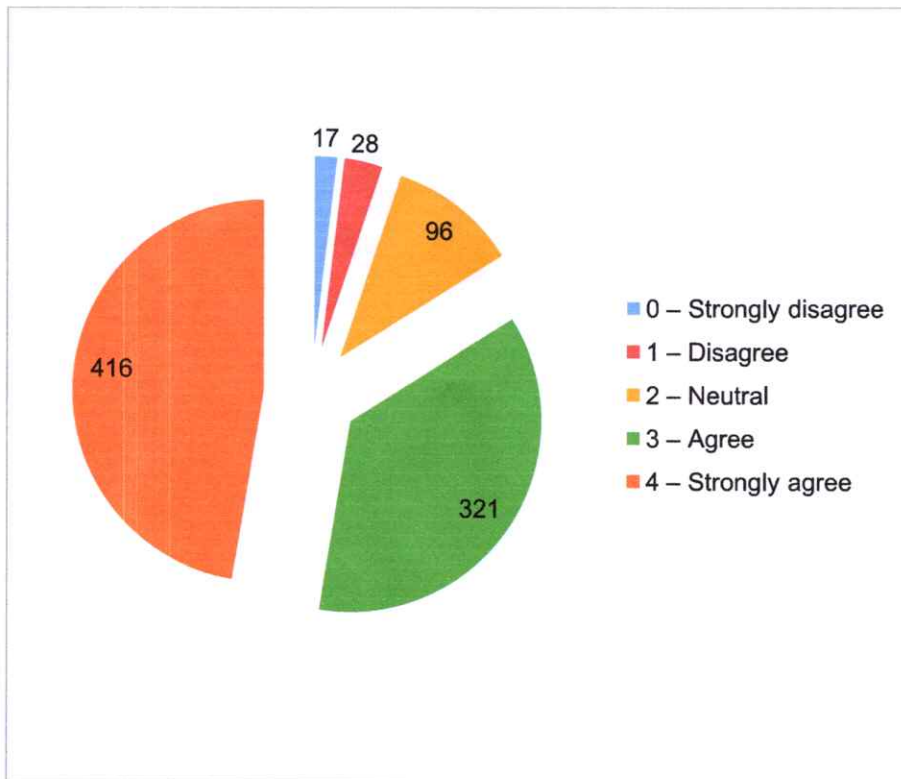


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17. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

The weightage average was found 3.24 and most of the students agreed that institution makes effort to engage students in the quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

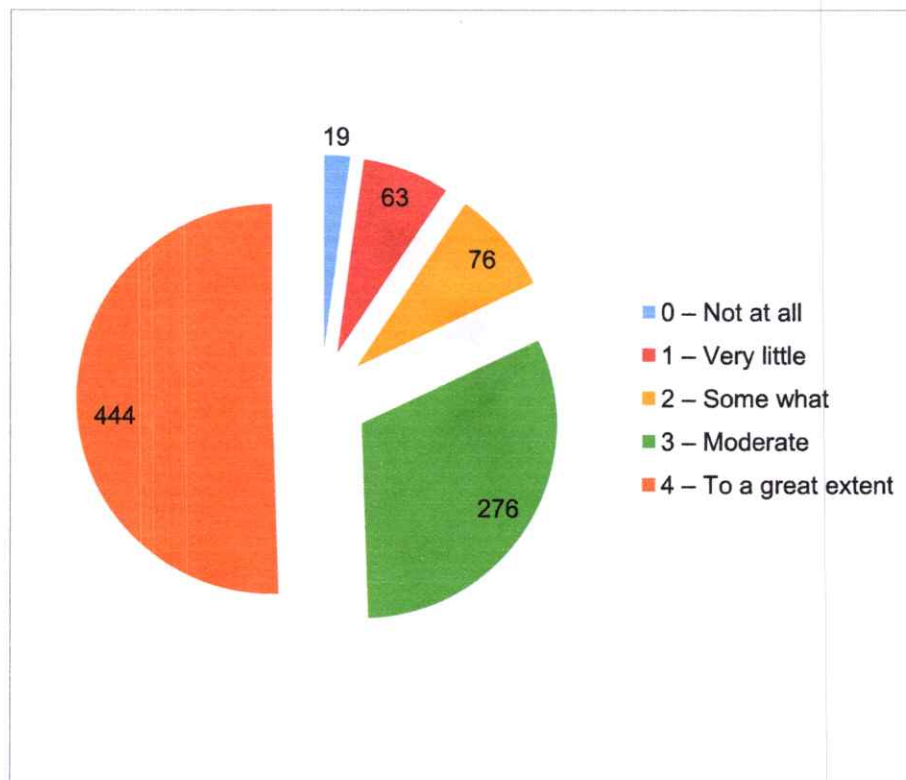


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18. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.

The weighted average was found 3.21 indicating that student centric methods are used by teachers for enhancing the learning experiences of students.

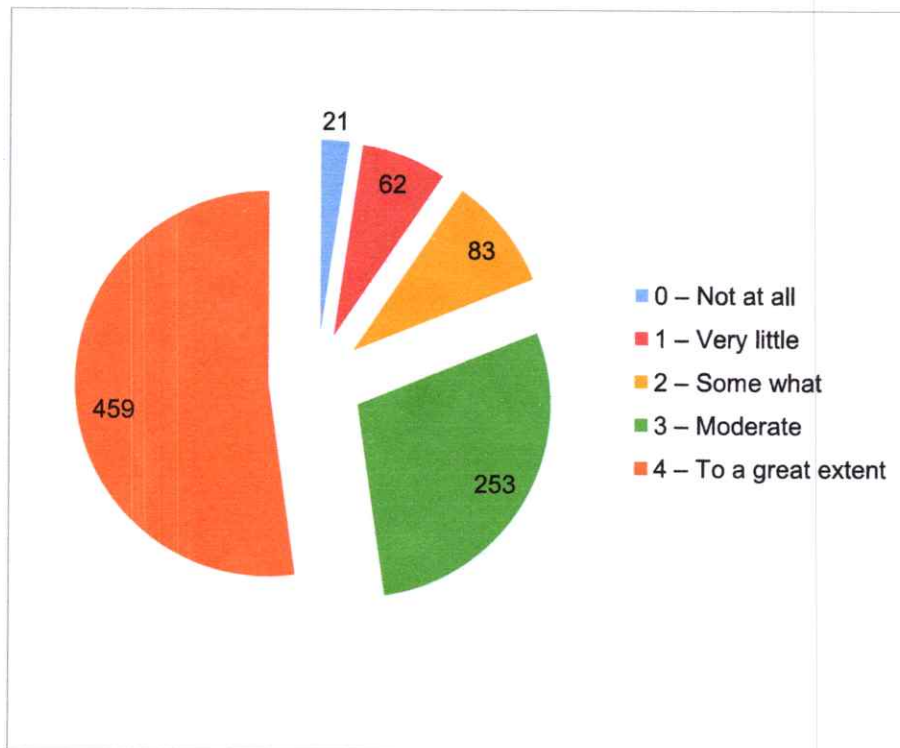


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19. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employ ability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

The weightage average was found 3.22 indicating considerable efforts being made by the teachers in skilling the students and making them ready for work life.

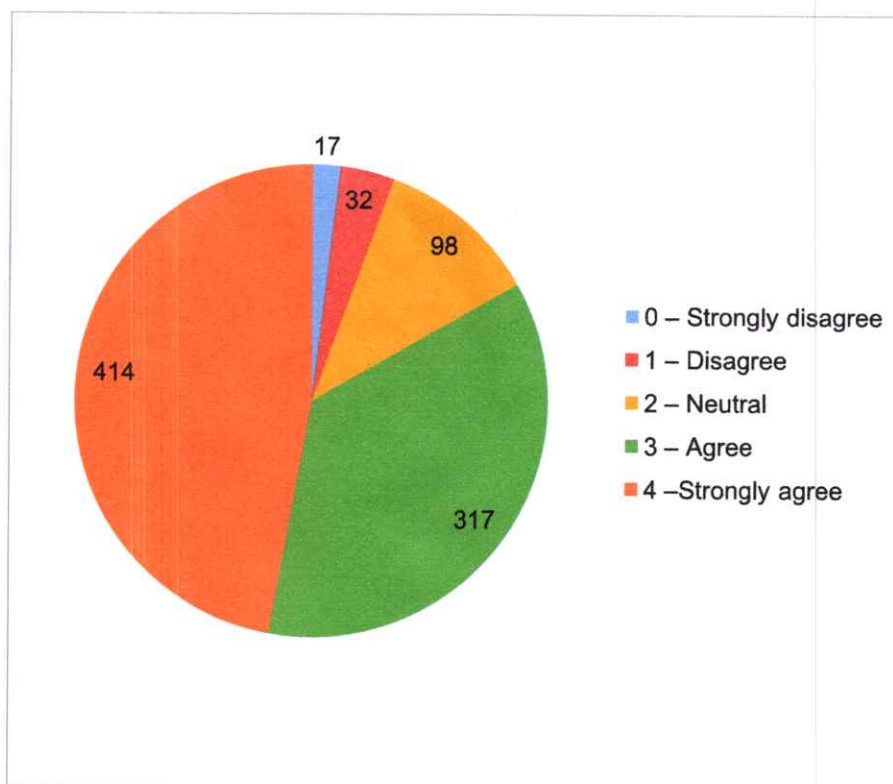


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20. The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good.

The weighted average was found 3.23 indicating that most of the students agree that the overall quality of the teaching-learning process at the University is very good.

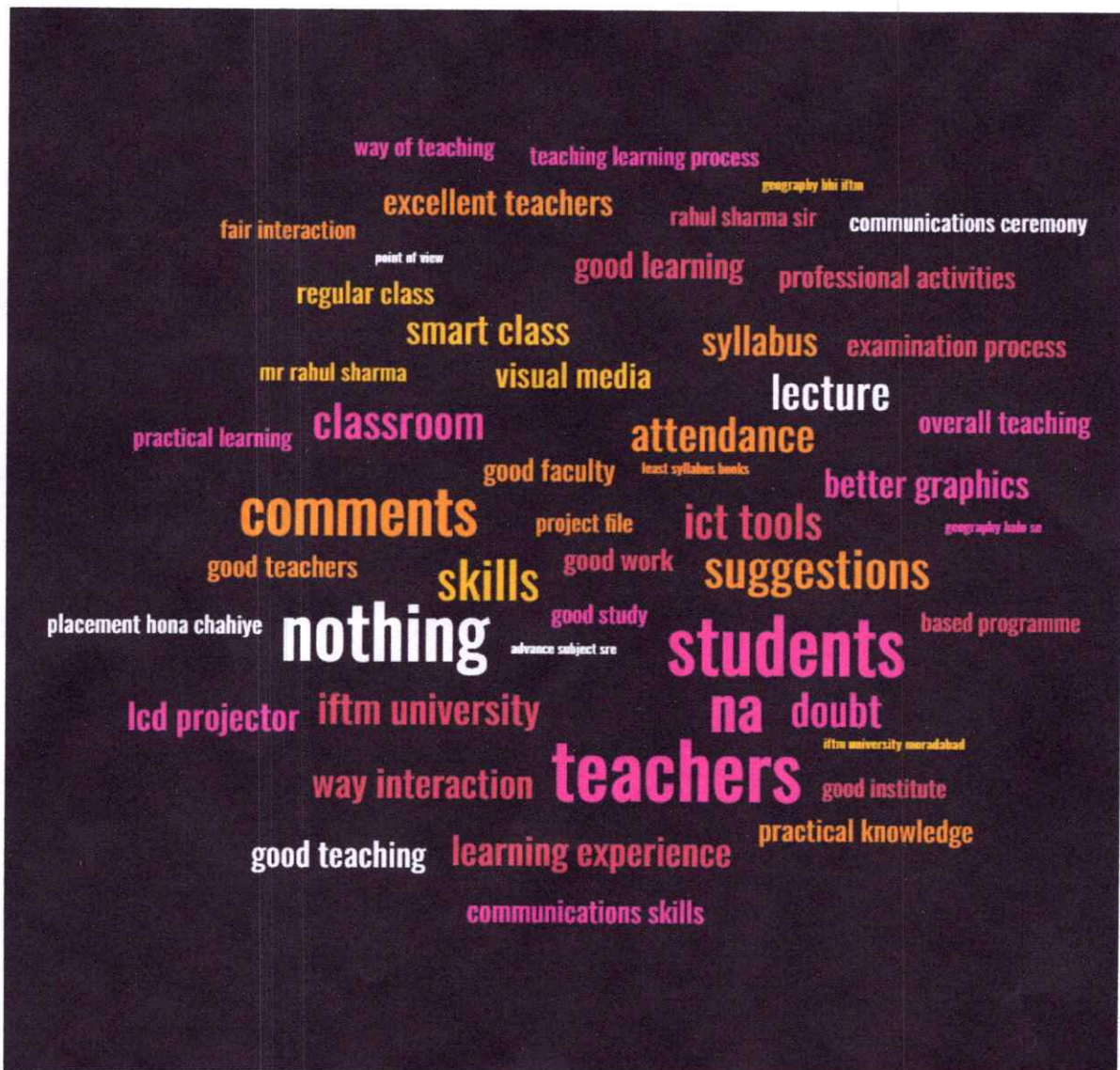


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21. Give three observation / suggestions to improve the overall teaching – learning experience in your institution.

To unveil the most talked about (buzz words) from the survey, a word cloud of 50 words was formed. It helped us learn about the themes, on which most suggestions were received and corrective measures were taken.



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While there were many positive sentiments being shared by the students, some areas of improvement were also uncovered. Viz.

1. Keywords “**New Technology / use ICT tools / smart class / visual media / lcd projector / projector / better graphics / ICT tools**”; all pertain to use of smart devices and technologies in classrooms. It was inferred that demand for Audio-Visual aids has increased.
2. **Extra-curricular activities** count needs to be increased.
3. More **industrial visits** have been sought by students.
4. The students have emphasized on need for **practical learning**.
5. The survey revealed that students expect better **placements**.

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
