Voice

Voice is a grammatical category that applies to verbs. Voice in English expresses the relationship of the subject to the action. Voice has two values. 1. Active voice

2. Passive voice

Difference Between


Active voice Passive voice


• The subject does the action

- The subject receives the action.
- The *Active voice* is the "normal" voice the one that we use most of the time. In In the active voice, the object receives the action of the verb the passive voice, the subject receives the action of the voice of the verb.

• Always use 3rd form of verb.

• Use different forms of verb.





1. Present Indefinite Rulesense

It is used to express an action in present time, habitual or usual actions or daily events or universal fact.

Passive voice

- Interrogative Sentence
 - Is a song sung by him?



2. Present Continuous Rulesnse

In Present Continuous, the action is on-going /still going on and hence continuous.

 - Plural: S+helping verb(are)+V 1st +ing +O

Negative Sentence

Singular: S+helping verb(is or am)+not+V 1st +ing+O

Plural: S+helping verb(are)+not+1st form of verb+O

Interrogative Sentence

Singular :helping verb(is or am)+S+1st form of verb+O?

Plural: Helping verb(are)+S+1st form of verb+ing+O?



Passive voice

Affirmative Sentence

Active voice

• Affirmative Sentence Jaan is

going to school.

Negative Sentence

Jaan is not going to school.

- Interrogative Sentence
 - Is Jaan going to school?



Passive voice

- Affirmative Sentence
 - School is being gone by Jaan.
- Negative Sentence
 - School is not being gone by Jaan.
- Interrogative Sentence
 - Is school being gone by Jaan?





In Present Perfect, the action is complete or has ended and hence termed perfect.



7. Future Indefinite Rulesnse

Simpal Future is used when we plan or make a decision to do something. Nothing is said about the time in the future.

Negative Sentence

The work will have not been finished by you.

 - Will the work have been finished by you?
