SCHOOL OF BIO TECHNOLOGY

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Based on the feedback survey conducted for the year 2019-20, a down trend was observed in some of the vital parameters. To address the issues, following measures were planned / taken.

1	Lesser number of students were found satisfied with the training and placement provided by the University.	<p>Director – T&P through his team explored more hands-on / live projects / field projects to help students acquaint with the real work life challenges. New organizations came on board to provide industry projects and full time job opportunities.</p> <p>a. Prospective employers covering various functions and industries were explored and reviewed for their suitability.</p> <p>b. Number of opportunities offered, types of roles offered, location and CTC offered, employers with high attrition rate (for our students), students' response to the opportunities viz. whether they applied, appeared and what was their performance (rejection, rejection level OR selection, joining and exit), was analyzed and appropriate measures including sessions with final year students, were taken.</p>
2	Some students were not satisfied with the facilities they got at the hostel of the University.	The hostel (both girls and boys) at the University campus provides all the amenities required by the students including the internet connectivity. Some electrical fittings (new and repair) were required in girls hostel, which was fixed by the electrician.
3	Few students did not concur that the learning experience they got had a real life application.	It was learnt that some students did pursue a career outside the field of bio-technology. Since the program is domain specific and is of technical nature, no further action was deemed necessary. The revision of the syllabus is to weed out

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		any redundancy is due in some time.
4	Some students opined that the computer facilities at the University shall be improved.	The computer lab accessible to the students of the department is equipped with all the software and applications that may be required by the students.
5	Many students opined about their dissatisfaction as they could not participate in the alumni meet	'Kutumb' the alumni meet was organized in early March 2020, however, not all the students could join because of multiple reasons. The time of the event is largely fixed and was decided after a thorough deliberation by the University officials.
6	Students had issues in getting their grievances resolved.	Students through their coordinators were advised to discuss all their issues / concerns with allotted mentors. Faculty logs the mentor-mentee interaction which is reviewed by concerned Director every month. In addition the students are made aware about the various cells and committees available to address their grievances where ever required.
7	Students were not completely satisfied with the laboratories and equipment.	The laboratory in the department gets updated with all the necessary inputs required for its functioning. The faulty and broken apparatus, scales and other equipment were changed, as part of routine activity.
